

ADVERTISEMENT FOR RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF CONSTABLE (GD) IN BORDER SECURITY FORCE THROUGH SPECIAL RECRUITMENT RALLY / DRIVE IN MEGHALAYA STATE FOR SCHEDULE TRIBES (ST) CANDIDATES - 2025.

Applications are invited from the male and female ST candidates belonging the state of Meghalaya (Domicile) for the post of Constable(General Duty) in Border Security Force (BSF) in the Level -3 (Rs.21,700 – 69,100) in the pay matrix as per 7th Central Pay Commission plus usual and admissible allowances to Central Govt. employees from time to time. In addition, Ration allowance, Medical Assistance, Uniform allowance, Free accommodation, LTC etc. as admissible to Central Govt. employees. The post has all India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and abroad. They will be governed under relevant BSF Act and Rules as well as CCS(Conduct) Rules as amended from time to time. The selected candidates will be governed by the New Contributory Pension Scheme (NPS), which came into effect from 1st January 2004 or the Unified Pension Scheme (UPS), as per option exercised by the candidate.

Note :- i) The vacancies are meant for BSF only and as per their merit.

ii) The vacancies may alter at later stage due to administrative reasons (may increase or decrease).

iii) 10% vacancies are earmarked for Ex-servicemen of ST category domiciled in Meghalaya. In case sufficient applications are not received, vacancies reserved for Ex-servicemen (ST category) will be filled up by fresh candidates (ST category) of Meghalaya domicile.

4. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**

- a) **Age** :- Between 18-28 years (including 5 years relaxation) as on 01.08.2025 i.e. candidates must have born not earlier than 02/08/1997 and not later than 01.08.2007.
- b) **Education** :- Minimum Matriculation or 10th class pass from recognized Board/University.

5. **PHYSICAL STANDARDS FOR ST CANDIDATES**

i) **PST**

- a) Height :- For male - 157 CMs
(Minimum) For female – 147.5 CMs
- b) Chest :- **For male only**
(Minimum) Unexpanded – 76 CMs
Expanded-Minimum expansion 5 CMs
- c) Weight :- For males and females proportionate to height and age as per medical standard.

ii) **PET**

- a) Male :- 5 KMs in 24 minutes.
- b) Female :- 1.6 KMs in 8.30 minutes.

iii) Incentives/ Bonus marks for NCC certificate holders shall be as under :-

- a) 'C' Certificate :- 5% of maximum marks of the examination.
- b) 'B' Certificate :- 3% of maximum marks of the examination
- c) 'A' Certificate :- 2% of maximum marks of the examination

iv) The cut off/ minimum qualifying percentage of marks in written examination for the candidates including Ex-Servicemen will be considered during preparation of merit.

Note :- Candidates who wish to be considered against vacancies reserve or seek age relaxation must submit requisite certificate from the Competent Authority. Otherwise, their claim for Schedule Tribe (ST) status will not be entertained and their candidature/applications will be rejected. The caste of the candidates who claim to be belonging to ST category should be enlisted the central list of Meghalaya issued by the prescribed authority.

6. MEDICAL STANDARD

The candidates will be medically examined in terms of guidelines for recruitment Medical Examinations in CAPFs and AR issued vide MHA UO No. A-VI-1/2014/Rectt(SSB) dated 20.05.2015, MHA OM No.E-32012/ADG (Med)/DME&RME/DA-1/2020(Part file)/1166 dated 31.05.2021 and subsequently amended from time to time.

Eye Sight:-

- i) The minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 both eyes without correction i.e. without wearing glasses.
- ii) Further the colour perception standard should be CP-III with details as under :-

The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eye/eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and physical health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

7. **ELIGIBILITY FOR RE-EMPLOYMENT OR EX-SERVICEMEN**

Ex-servicemen being trained solders, only written test and medical fitness test will be conducted to ascertain their medical category. Relaxation of upper age limit to the extent service plus 3 years is applicable. However, break in Army service and re-employment should not exceed 2 years. No physical efficiency test will be held for Ex-servicemen.

8. Person serving in Govt./semi-Govt. Department may submit their applications alongwith No Objection Certificate (NOC) issued by their concerned Organization.

- A) Candidates who fulfill the above education, physical and medical standards should personally appear at nearest Centre of examination in any one of the following Recruiting Centers along with enrolment form duly completed in all respect and documents as mentioned below for collection of Admit Card by hand for appearing PST, PET and subsequent events for their selection as Constable(GD) in BSF :-

The candidates while reporting at the examination centers will bring along with them a duly filled form as per the prescribed format at Annexure –A & A-I (must be in 03 sets alongwith photocopies of pertaining documents). The application form should be only typed (in English) on one side only in full scape plain paper with passport size photograph affixed at prescribed place in the application form. The application forms should be enclosed with the following documents:-

- i) Candidates have to fill up the application form only in Hindi or English language.
- ii) Self-attested copies of certificates/testimonials as proof of education as well as date of birth.
- iii) Self-attested copy of Caste Certificate (ST) issued by the prescribed authority.
- iv) Self-attested copy of Domicile certificate and any one of the identity proof i.e. Aadhar card, Voter ID or Ration Card Etc.
- v) A form for issue of Admit card will also be filled in and submitted alongwith passport size photograph as per Annexure-II alongwith the application form.

B) INCOMPLETE APPLICATION WILL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED AND NO CORRESPONDENCE ON THIS WILL BE ENTERTAINED.

- C)** Admit Card with roll number and general instructions for appearing to the selection process will be issued to the eligible candidates after successful submission and registration of their application forms at the Examination centers. They will be called to appear for the selection test at the PST/PET center on the subsequent day/days. No TA/DA is admissible for the candidates.

10. RECRUITMENT PROCESS VIZ PHYSICAL STANDARD TEST (PST),
PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST (PET) AND WRITTEN TEST

Candidate who have been issued Admit Cards will report at the PST & PET center on the given date and time to undergo the following process:-

- a) All eligible candidates will be asked to go through the Height Bar and thereby, candidates with lesser height will get eliminated.
- b) Those candidates who qualify the Height Bar will be subjected to 5 KMs race (for Male) and 1.6 KMs (for Female) to be completed within 24 minutes and 8.30 minutes respectively.
- c) Physical efficiency tests will be only qualifying in nature and it will not carry any marks. If the qualifying candidates are more than the vacancy, merit of the candidates will be decided during final result/selection.
- d) Testimonials of the candidates will be checked after the identification process and eligible candidates will go to the next step.
- e) Candidates who are found eligible on screening of testimonials will be screened first for height, chest and weight (weight will not be a disqualification at the stage of PST). However, it will be assessed for disqualification during medical examination (with reference to height/age standard chart) measurements.
- f) The candidates who qualify on the PST & PET will be required to appear for the written test.
- g) The question paper will be of 100 marks comprising of 100 questions. The duration of question paper will be 02 hours.
- h) The question paper of written examination will be set to assess the general awareness/general knowledge, knowledge of elementary mathematics, analytical aptitude and ability to observe and distinguish patterns and to test the basic knowledge of the candidate in Hindi/English language
- i) The question papers will be prepared in Hindi & English languages.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Candidates declared qualified in the written test will be shortlisted for appearing for Document verification followed by Medical Examination Test in proportionate to the available vacancies.

- a) Medical Examination as per BSF Medical Manual, Uniform guidelines issued vide MHA UO No. A-VI-1/2014/Rectt(SSB) dated 20.05.2015, MHA OM No.E-32012/ADG(Med)/ DME&RME/DA-1/2020(Part file)/1166 dated 31.05.2021 and subsequent instructions for conducting medical examination issued by ADG(Medical), CAPFs.
- b) **Tattoo :-** Following criteria has been fixed to determine permissibility of Tattoo:-
 - i) **Content:-** Tattoo religious symbol or figures and the name, as followed in Indian Army are to be permitted.
 - ii) **Location:-** Tattoos marked on traditional site of the body lie inner aspect of forearm, but only left forearm, being non saluting limb or dorsum of the hands will be allowed.
 - iii) **Size:-** Must be less than $\frac{1}{4}$ of the particular part (Elbow or hand) of the body.

Note :-

- (i) Candidates reporting at the PST & PET centers after 11/10/2025 for registration of their applications, will not be entertained.
- (ii) Incomplete application form will be rejected straightway. In case, the documents submitted by the candidates are found fake during verification after recruitment, the candidate will be dealt under the provision of BSF Act & Rules and his services can be terminated without any financial benefits.
